What brought you to RCIA?

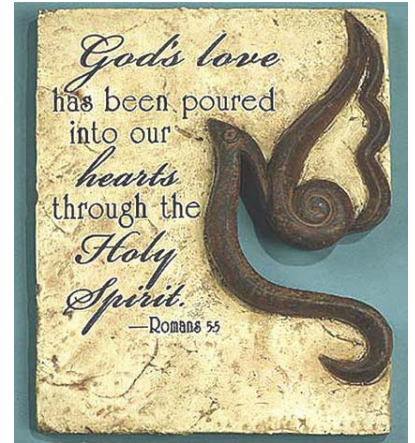
